BREXIT: USING THE EHIC CARD IN GREECE AFTER 01.01.2021

From **1 January 2021**, there will be two categories for EHIC UK holders temporarily staying in Greece:

- those covered by the **Withdrawal Agreement**, who exercised free movement rights and stayed in Greece prior to the end of the transition period (31 December 2020) or will stay in Greece after 1st January 2021,
- those covered by the **EU-UK Trade Cooperation Agreement- Social Security Coordination Protocol** and move to Greece for a temporary stay after 1st January 2021.

The beneficiaries of the first category, whose rights are protected under the **Withdrawal Agreement** and who are **UK-issued EHIC («EHIC CRA UK»)** holders, can still have access to necessary medical treatment during their temporary stay in Greece, as long as they are entitled to do so.

The beneficiaries of the second category, who temporarily stay in Greece after 1 January 2021 and who are **Global Health Insurance Card holders - GHIC holders, European Health Insurance Card – EHIC holders** (as long as it is valid) or **Provisional Replacement Certificate -PRC UK holders** can also have access to necessary medical treatment in Greece, as long as they are eligible for 90 days within an 180-day period.
